### PLEASE KNOW WHERE AND WHEN TO BE AND WHAT IS EXPECTED

1. Please follow the following procedure for **all** Winter Guard Events:

A. Report to the high school at the time listed above.

B. All students must ride the bus to and from the event. If you would like to take your child home after their performance, you and your parent must physically see/speak to Mr. Barthen.

C. **YOU MUST PRESENT A NOTE FROM YOUR PARENTS IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO RIDE HOME WITH A PARENTAL TYPE ADULT OTHER THAN YOUR OWN PARENTS. I CANNOT BE FLEXIBLE ON THIS RULE.**

D. **YOU MAY NOT RIDE HOME WITH A STUDENT OR NON –PARENTAL UNIT. IF THERE ARE QUESTIONS, YOUR PARENTS SHOULD DISCUSS THE SITUATION WITH MR. BARTHEN PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION.**

E. You may not ride home with anyone who does not have the MASD Agreement and Release and Hold Harmless Form on File with the Athletic Department prior to picking-up your child. This includes a copy of your Automobile Declaration Page.

D. The use of stereo equipment without headphones on the bus is PROHIBITED.

E. Use cell phones according to the Band Handbook rules. You may call for a ride when we enter school grounds.

F. **Be sure to use the restroom before leaving the school.**

G. Please remember to report any medical concerns or illnesses immediately to Mr. Barthen, Jen Minamy, or any of the staff members or adult chaperones.

H. Do not wander through the building, stay in the band area.

I. Proper bus discipline and etiquette is required and must be followed!

J. **Do not spray hairspray, perfume, lotion, or anything smelly on the bus!**

K. Remember that you represent Moon Area High School, please act appropriately. Do not do anything that will need to be explained.

L. **ALL SCHOOL RULES APPLY.**

\* M. Please act appropriately when watching other groups, in the halls, using the dressing room facilities, etc. Keep comments to yourselves about other groups, your performance, etc.

- Please secure all your belongings when leaving to perform. Do not leave, phones, money, jewelry, etc. in your bag. Give them to a chaperone to hold while performing.

- Do not wonder outside the host school after your performance obligations are completed.

- Do not walk around inside the school by yourself, stay in a group!

- The host school, and/or MASD is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

### Additional Information:

A. Bring a change of clothes and shoes for when you are done performing! You will need to change out of your uniform after performing.

The Norwin Band Boosters will be operating a concession area in the cafeteria. It is STRONGLY advised to bring the appropriate funds for eating. We will not be stopping on the return trip.
