- 1. FULL AND 1st HALF STUDENTS REPORT TO THE HIGH SCHOOL VIA THE NATATORIUM AT 5:15 PM**
- 2. 2nd HALF STUDENTS REPORT TO THE HIGH SCHOOL VIA THE NATATORIUM AT 7:00PM**
- 3. Kick-off is at 7:00 pm**

4. GAME should conclude at around 10:15PM

Please remember, whenever a return time is listed, this is at best, an educated guess. Games conditions are not controllable and sometimes cause unforeseen delays.

2. PLEASE FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE FOR ALL HOME MARCHING BAND EVENTS:

- Report to the high school at the time listed above. **USE THE NATATORIUM ENTRANCE!**
- Students MUST HAVE FACE COVERING AND WATER JUG.**
- Students MUST complete the Band Pre-Health Screening with Temperature Check.**
- Face Covering must be worn at all times while inside the building and when NOT engaged in playing your instrument.
- Students and Chaperones are reminded **NOT TO PARK** in the Natatorium Lot!
- Upon arrival at school, retrieve your uniform from the closet and dress in the hallways
- After dressing, proceed to your warm-up arc in the **STUDENT ENTRANCE AREA**, where inspection of shoes, hat, socks, gloves, gauntlets and uniform will be done while warming-up.
- Be sure to use the restroom before leaving the school.
- Do not wander through the building, stay in the band area.
- Please remember to report any medical concerns or illnesses immediately to Mr. Barthen or any of the staff members.
- Remember that you represent Moon Area High School Marching Band, please act appropriately. No foul language, etc.
- USE CELL PHONES AS DESCRIBED IN THE BAND HANDBOOK.** Students are not permitted to use cell phones for any reason while in the stands. If there is an emergency, go to a staff member and ask to use your phone. When caught, they will be confiscated and given back to a parent at the conclusion of the activity. **ALL SCHOOL RULES APPLY.**

4. UNIFORM HIGHLIGHTS:

- Shoes are to be cleaned and polished for every event. This will be checked before leaving for the field.
- Long hair must be pulled up out of your face to fit underneath the hat.**
- Jewelry is limited to small stud earrings, watches, necklaces must be hidden underneath uniform.
- Dress appropriately for the weather during the day.
 - You must have clothes on under the uniform, not just undergarments.**
 - You must wear the Moon Band T-shirt.**
 - NO JEANS OR JEANS SHORT ARE TO BE WORN UNDERNEATH YOUR UNIFORM.**
 - BLACK (above the ankle length) SOCKS MUST BE WORN!!!**
 - Uniforms will remain at school after every performance. Cleaning will be handled through the school.

Additional Performances

We have additional performances planned for the bands throughout the month of September and early October. With the changing environment and rules, I cannot provide those dates or details at this time. As soon as the performance information is available, I will forward. I apologize for the changes.

FOOTBALL GAME INFORMATION – from 9/7 Parent e-mail and posting

While the Allegheny Health Department has increased the maximum outdoor cohort gatherings to 100, we must still abide by the 250 PA State DOH mandate in regard to outdoor sporting events while inside the stadium. We have been approved for 50 participants during the MAHS Varsity Football games and an additional 15 during halftime. When the game is being played, the band will need to rotate students within each band to accomplish this requirement. I have taken the roster and assigned splits to the underclassmen when we are playing in the stands while the game is in progress. Please read the descriptions of the procedures to make this work.

Student Attending the Entire Game - FULL

If your student is assigned to attend the MAHS Varsity Football game for the entire game (full), students will report at 5:15 PM to the high school band room via the Natatorium entrance of the High School to dress and prepare for the game. These students will dress, warm-up, perform pre-game, perform halftime, and participate in the game activities while in the stands for the entire game. At the conclusion of the game, student can be picked up at the Natatorium Entrance of the High School.

Students driving to the game should park in the faculty lot closest to the Art Classrooms. You will NOT be permitted to park in the Natatorium Parking Lot. Student Drivers are also REMINDED, if you arrive later, after 5:30PM, you will NOT be permitted to park on campus.

Student Attending 1st Half of Game - SPLIT – Attend 1st

If your student is assigned a split and are to perform for the first half of the game “ATTEND 1st”, students will report at 5:15 PM to the high school band room via the High School Natatorium entrance to dress and prepare for the game. These students will perform in pre-game, halftime and participate in the game activities in the stands for the 1st half of the game (before halftime). Students will then be dismissed after the halftime performance. Students will need to be picked-up at the High

School Lot located closest to Bob Evans off of University Boulevard. Students should text/call parents for a ride when back at the high school changing out of their uniform. The Campus will be closed to traffic and you will only be permitted to enter campus via University Boulevard and then turn into the High School Lot located closest to Bob Evans to pick-up your student. Your Student will be provided with a card designating to the School Security you are permitted to enter campus.

Student Attending 2nd Half of Game – SPLIT – Attend 2nd

If your student is assigned a split and are to perform for halftime and the second part of the game, “Attend 2nd” students will report at 7:00pm. These students will be dropped off at the High School Lot located closest to Bob Evans via the University Boulevard Entrance and enter the High School through the Natatorium Entrance. The Campus will be closed to traffic, you will only be permitted to enter campus via University Boulevard and then turn into the lot to drop-off your student. Your Student will be provided with a card designating to the School Security you are permitted to enter campus. 2nd Half Split students will dress, prepare for the game, join the rest of the band to perform halftime, then participate in the game activities in the stands for the 2nd half of the game (after halftime) and be dismissed at the conclusion of the game. Pickup location for dismissal will be at the Natatorium Entrance of the High School.

Campus will be closed to all traffic at 5:30 PM and opened at the conclusion of the game, hence the reason the group report and dismissal format.

Viewing Performances/Games

Spectators will not be permitted in the stadium or on campus. MASD will be live streaming the games as well as MCA-TV will be filming and broadcasting the games. Final information is being formulated in order for parents, relatives, and community can view the performances. Information will be distributed once details are known.
